The Petition for Extraordinary Relief was filed without the payment of the \$375.00 filing fee or an application for waiver of filing fee. If evidence of payment of the filing fee or application for waiver of filing fee is not received by this court within such time period, the petition will be submitted for dismissal.

All documents must be filed with the appellate court clerk. Documents submitted by attorneys must be submitted through the appellate e-filing system. Self-represented parties may file by email, by mail, or in person. Documents must be a searchable PDF of no more than 7 MB. Large PDF documents must be divided into multiple files of no more than 7 MB each. Unless the court orders otherwise, the filing of documents and briefs is timely if the electronic filing is received before midnight on the last day for filing. A document is deemed filed when the electronic filing is received. Sending an electronic filing is an electronic signature, and it carries all of the representations and

consequences under Rule 40, Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure. If a document other than a brief is delivered electronically, a paper copy does not need to be delivered. See Rules 21 and 26 of the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure. All risks associated with filing electronically are borne by the sender. The court emails all documents to the email listed on the State Bar's website for attorneys, or to the email provided by self-represented parties.
